Featured Display:

AC-47 "Spooky" - fixed-wing gunship developed by the United States Air Force during the Vietnam War. Spooky was equipped with 3 7.62 mm General Electric mini-guns to fire through two rear window openings and the side cargo door, all on the left (pilot's) side of the aircraft. AC-47s proved popular with ground forces during the Vietnam War.

Featured Aircraft Rides (and display):

B-25 "Miss Mitchell"- medium range bomber. The B-25 aircraft is famous for being launched from the deck of an aircraft carrier in the Pacific Ocean and bombing mainland Japan as part of Lt. Col. James "Jimmy" Doolittle, "Doolittle's Raid." The B-25J "Miss Mitchell" served in the 310th Bomb Group, 57th Bomb Wing of the 12th Air Force in North Africa and Italy completing over 130 missions.

C-47 "That's all Brother" June 6, 1944, That's All, Brother led the main airborne invasion of Normandy (D-Day). Piloted by Lt. Col John Donalson, this plane led over 800 C-47s to drop over 13,000 paratroopers. "That's All, Brother" has been restored to its 1944 condition, including its D-Day paint scheme along with a thorough historic interior restoration.

SBD Dauntless Dive Bomber- WW2 carrier-based scout, dive and torpedo bomber. The "Dauntless" helped turn the tide of World War II at the Battle of Midway on June 4, 1942. Currently only 2 Flying and ride capable Dauntless in the whole world left!

SNJ- Commonly called "T-6 Texan" From 1943- Advanced Trainer plane for pilots before moving on to flying single seat fighters.

BT-13 Valiant, sometimes known as the "Vibrator" - Basic WW2 Pilot Trainer
